HISTORICAL VILLAGE THANKS SAN-CAP ROTARY

January 28, 2016 - The Sanibel-Captiva Rotary Club recently donated \$4,000 to the Sanibel Historical Village. The money is to mitigate the cost of new pavers on the walkways throughout the village, replacing the old boardwalk-style paths.
